5E. For Survey Periods 2 and 3, if the District Number, Current Enrollment and the District Number, Current Instruction/Service are equal and the School Number, Current Enrollment is found on the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) Reference file - F71447 (provided by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services), and

- **If the NSLP designated at the school is determined by collection of Free or Reduced Priced Lunch Eligibility Applications, then Lunch Status must equal 0, 1, 2 or 3 or,**
- **If the NSLP is designated as a school providing Provision 2, then Lunch Status must equal 4 or,**
- **If the NSLP is designated as a school providing Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), then Lunch Status must equal C or N. - state validation-**

The match should be made using Year; District Number, Current Enrollment; and School Number, Current Enrollment.

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Lunch Status equals 2 (eligible for free lunch based on eligibility application), but in the NSLP Reference File, Lunch Program Type is equivalent to CEP.

Data Element Name: **Lunch Status**

Lunch status is defined as the student's eligibility for participation in the Free, Reduced or Full Price Lunch Program of the district as evidenced by submission of an application.

Code	Definition/Example
0	The student did not apply for free or reduced price lunch.
1	The student applied for free or reduced price lunch but is not eligible.
2	The student is eligible for free lunch.
3	The student is eligible for reduced-price lunch.
4	The student is enrolled in a USDA-approved Provision 2 school.
6	The student is eligible for free meals based on direct certification which is the automatic approval for free meals but declines the free meals.
9	The student is eligible for free meals based on direct certification which is the automatic approval for free meals.
C	The student is enrolled in a USDA – approved Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school and is identified as eligible for free meals based upon the Direct Certification determination or the extension of eligibility to the household due to eligibility of an identified direct certified student. Identified students include students directly certified through SNAP; TANF; the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations; children experiencing homelessness who have been identified on the local liaison's list; Head Start participants; identified migrant youth; identified runaways; non-applicants approved by local officials; foster children who are certified through means other than a household application; and those eligible for Medicaid. (Only FL Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) - approved CEP schools use this code.)
N	The student is enrolled in a USDA – approved Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school and is NOT identified as eligible for free meals based upon the Direct Certification determination or the extension of eligibility to the household due to eligibility of an identified direct certified student. (Only FDACS - approved CEP schools use this code.)
Z	Unknown. This code should be used only for private school students participating in Title I programs and (optionally) for reporting survey 6 information.

NOTE: (a) Only codes 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, C and N are submitted to the state. Codes 6 and 9 should be converted to code 2 or C, as appropriate for the National School Lunch Program Provision offered in the school, prior to state reporting.
 (b) If a student is eligible for free or reduced price lunch at any time during the school year, report the student as such in Survey 5.
