PRIOR SCHOOL STATUS/STUDENT ATTENDANCE - REJECT RULES



14. Prior School/Location: District/County must be numeric and in the range 01-68, 71-75, 80 or 99. -record rejected-

Note: See DOE Information Database Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information System Manual, Appendix C for appropriate District/County Numbers.

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second and third records would be rejected because the Prior School/Location: District/County is not in the appropriate range.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the database, the district must correct Prior School/Location: District/County and resubmit the records.

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION – REJECT RULES



1. District Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numerical and in the range 01-68 or 80.-record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Instruction/Service is not in the appropriate range.

District Number, Current Instruction/Service	Florida Education Identifier

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the District Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the record.

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION – REJECT RULES



16. District Number, Current Enrollment must be numeric and in the range 01-68 or 80. -record rejected-

The first two records listed below would be written to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the District Number, Current Enrollment is not in the appropriate range.
