

CELLA Communiqué #9

2009 CELLA Score Report Update

This communiqué updates the scanning, scoring, and reporting of student results from the 2009 CELLA administration and information about shipping and receipt of reports.

Score Report Delivery Dates

The FDOE must approve sample CELLA reports before the distribution of score reports can begin. Specific districts are selected to participate in a **Mini-State Test**. Paper student score reports are printed. School, district, and state reports are provided on CD to validate the scoring and reporting processes are 100% accurate, and properly display the changes for the 2009 test administration. During this process, the print quality and the packaging of the score reports are checked. In addition, the ETS staff checked the results to ensure the test was completed successfully. For 2009, the Mini-State districts are Bay #03, Flagler #18, and Hardee #25. **The Mini-State was reviewed and approved by the FDOE.**

After approval, ETS released **Shipment #1** of paper score reports for students and CD reports for schools and districts based on the date all test materials were returned. Please refer to the chart below for guidance on when you should receive your score reports:

Print Report and CD Report Shipments

The district's printed student reports (two copies per student) will arrive separately from the CD containing school and district results. The CD will be shipped to the district address, in a small package, via UPS 2nd Day and will arrive prior to the printed reports. Printed reports will be shipped via K2 Logistics.

ETS will send an e-mail notice when your print and CD reports have been shipped, including the tracking numbers for these shipments.

What's New?

- School, District and State Reports will be provided on CD. No printed paper copies will be provided. The layouts of these reports have not changed and blank pages were inserted so that summary reports for each grade began on a new page, easing distribution.
- A table displaying CELLA Proficiency Levels as a scale score range, by domain and grade level is on the front side of each **Student Score Report**. Proficiency level descriptors explaining CELLA scores are also included in English and Spanish.
- When Combined Average Scale Score is NR in **any** section (Reading or Writing or Listening/Speaking) on a District Report, **NR** will be displayed for Total Average Scale Score.
- The print version of the 2009 Interpretive Guide is only provided in English and Spanish; however all eleven most common Florida languages (English, Arabic, Chinese, French, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Urdu, and Vietnamese) are available for download on the CELLA website <http://www.fldoe.org/aala/cELLa.asp>
