

### Subgroup Graduation Rate: Pre-Pandemic (2018-19) compared to Today (2021-22)

- The statewide graduation rate among Black/African American students increased by 0.5 percentage points compared to 2018-19, rising from 81.5 percent in 2018-19 to 82.0 percent in 2021-22.
- The graduation rate gap between White and Black/African American students decreased by 0.1 percentage points compared to 2018-19; the gap in 2018-19 was 8.7 percentage points, and the gap in 2021-22 is 8.6 percentage points.
- The statewide graduation rate among Hispanic students remained the same compared to 2018-19, with a graduation rate of 85.9 percent in 2018-19 and 2021-22.
- The statewide graduation rate among students with disabilities increased by 2.9 percentage points compared to 2018-19, rising from 80.6 percent in 2018-19 to 83.5 percent in 2021-22.
- The statewide graduation rate among economically disadvantaged students increased by 0.2 percentage points compared to 2018-19, rising from 82.9 percent in 2018-19 to 83.1 percent in 2021-22.
- The statewide graduation rate among English Language Learner students decreased by 2 percentage points compared to 2018-19, falling from 75.0 percent in 2018-19 to 73.0 percent in 2021-22.
