**CONTINUING EDUCATION #** = Of the Students Reported, the number found continuing their education in the fall semester of 2015 or the winter/spring semester of 2016 by gender and race.

**CONTINUING EDUCATION %** = Continuing Education # divided by Students Reported.

**FOUND EMPLOYED #** = Of the Students Reported, the number found employed in the October-December quarter of 2015.

**FOUND EMPLOYED %** = Found Employed # divided by Students Reported.

**CONT. ED. & EMPLOYED #** = Of the Students Reported, the number of students found Continuing Education and Found Employed.

**CONT. ED. & EMPLOYED %** = Cont. Ed. & Employed # divided by Students Reported.

**CONT. ED. or EMPLOYED #** = Of the Students Reported, the number of students found Continuing Education or Found Employed.

**CONT. ED. or EMPLOYED %** = Cont. Ed. & Employed # divided by Students Reported.

**UNKNOWN GENDER** = Unknown represents unreported or invalid gender.

**UNKNOWN RACE** = Unknown represents unreported or invalid race.

**Note:** Values are displayed when 10 or more students are counted.

Values less than 10, but greater than 0 are suppressed with (\*\*\*\*) for numeric values and (\*\*\*) for percent values.

Values equal to 0 are suppressed with (-) for numeric values.

Percent values are suppressed when the numerator is less than 10 and the denominator is 10 or more.
