 Pursuant to s. 1003.03(4)(d), F.S., the commissioner must prepare a reallocation of the funds made available for the districts that have fully met the class size requirement for both traditional schools and district-operated schools of choice. The funds shall be reallocated by calculating an amount of up to 5 percent of the Base Student Allocation multiplied by the total district FTE students. The reallocation total may not exceed 25 percent of the total funds reduced.
