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

## MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Cosmetology Hours

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We have had several discussions with the Director of the Florida Board of Cosmetology in an effort to resolve the concerns expressed by the field relating to the sequencing of the hours and services in the Cosmetology program (8757200/1120404). For the current year (2009-10) the Cosmetology program will be given flexibility in sequencing the hours and services required to complete the minimum standards, as well as the 10 facial and 20 nail services required for the Cosmetology license in Rules 61G5-22.006 and 61G5-22.0125 Florida Administrative Code (FAC). This will apply to students who are currently enrolled in the Cosmetology program and are seeking only the Cosmetology license, and not the Facials Specialty and/or Nails Specialty license.

If a student is currently enrolled in the Cosmetology program and does intend to obtain the Facials Specialty and/or Nails Specialty license(s), they should continue to take the courses as listed in the current 2009-10 framework. The course numbers, structure, and Occupational Completion Points (OCP) will remain the same for the current 2009-10 school year.

For 2010-11 it will be restructured with only one OCP. Below are the proposed program sequences for 2010-11 for both the Secondary and PSAV levels.
