SUBJECT: Regional Career Pathways Agreements Submissions

DEADLINE: May 1, 2022

Section 1007.233, Florida Statutes, requires Florida College System (FCS) institutions to submit a regional career pathways agreement for each certificate program offered by the career center in their service area that is aligned with the FCS institution's associate degree programs. The agreements must be submitted annually to the Department of Education on or before May 1. Appendix A includes the required components for regional agreements.

For 2021-2022, FCS institutions will use the attached spreadsheet to verify and submit regional or statewide career pathways agreements on behalf of the college and its respective career center(s).

In lieu of executing a regional career pathway agreement, FCS institutions and career centers may use an existing <u>Statewide Career Pathways Agreement</u>, which guarantees minimum college credit. The presence of a statewide agreement does not preclude the awarding of additional credits by any FCS institution through a regional career pathways agreement; however, regional agreements may not award less college credit than the amount guaranteed through an existing statewide agreement.

All completed spreadsheets are due to <u>articulation@fldoe.org</u> by May 1, 2022. A copy of all new and amended agreements must also be emailed to the department with your spreadsheet submission.

Appendix A: Regional Career Pathways Agreement Core Elements

Student Validation Mechanism	A statement that explains how students are awarded credit toward award of the associate degree upon initial enrollment in the program.	Recommended
Career Certificate Completion Requirements	A description and/or listing of the career certificate completion requirements, which may include information about demonstration of Basic Skills Exit requirements, satisfactory GPA, or other completion information identified in the career center's student catalog.	Yes

Licenses or industry certifications	A description and/or listing of any licenses or industry certifications (if applicable) that must be earned before enrolling in an associate program associated with the agreement.	Yes, if applicable
Admissions information	A description of the FCS institution's admissions requirements, including those mandatory for the corresponding associate degree program named within the agreement, as well as the assessment for college-level readiness in computation and communication outlined in s. 1008.30, F.S., and Rule 6A-10.0315(2), Florida Administrative Code.	Recommended
Limitations	A statement detailing the length of time within which career certificate graduates must enroll in the corresponding associate degree program in order to be granted college credit guaranteed by the receiving FCS institution's regional agreement.	Yes
Signature lines	Signatures of FCS institution president, district superintendent and career center director (or their designees) involved in regional agreement implementation.	Yes
Review and renewal date (if applicable)	A description of when the agreement is scheduled to be reviewed for renewal, modification or termination.	Yes
