SUBJECT: **Industry Certification – Additional FTE in the 2021-22 Florida Education Finance Program, Third Calculation**

The Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) includes additional full-time equivalent (FTE) membership in the calculation for students who earned industry certifications while enrolled in registered career-themed courses. The Florida Department of Education has completed the 2021- 22 FEFP, Third Calculation. This calculation is based on data submitted by districts for the 2020- 21 reporting year.

The department’s management information systems (MIS) staff have created the following student-level report which your district MIS staff may access.
