On Friday, the Governor issued Executive Order 20-213. It extends the state of emergency declared in Executive Order 20-52 for 60 days. As many of you know, those waivers provided for in Section 9 of Department of Education Emergency Order (EO) 2020-01, in addition to those simulation accommodations and other flexibilities associated with our CTE programs (specifically our health sciences programs), which are attached to the life of Executive Order 20-52, are now extended.
