SUBJECT: DOH Emergency Orders and CTE Health Science Programs

Colleagues,

The attached matrix was designed to help provide clarity around the waivers the Florida Department of Health (DOH) has recently issued. As many of you undoubtedly already know, these waivers allow for certain simulation and videoconferencing in place of live patient contact requirements. Of particular note, we would like to bring to your attention to new waivers provided in DOH EO 20-010 which provides for the following:

- Emergency medical services training programs may, with the approval of the training program medical director, substitute supervised remote live videoconferencing or simulation for clinical, and field internship requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 64J-1.020(6), until the expiration of Executive Order No. 20-52, unless extended.
