**SUBJECT:** Executive Order 20-52

## Colleagues,

Please see the attached Executive Order 21-45. It extends the state of emergency declared in Executive Order 20-52 for 60 days, or through Tuesday, April 27<sup>th</sup> 2021.

You may recall that many waivers provided through Department of Health (DOH) Emergency Orders are attached to the life of Executive Order 20-52. Additionally, on December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020, DOH Emergency Order No. 20-15 extended the suspensions of the provisions around skills demonstration for the examination for Certified Nursing Assistant candidates. It also extended the suspensions of the provisions around the use of mannequins or simulated patients for the skills demonstration portion of the examination for Dental Hygiene. Both extensions apply until March 31<sup>st</sup> 2021. Should we receive any updates prior to March 31<sup>st</sup> we will certainly communicate them. Note the third attachment, a helpful matrix.
