SUBJECT: Updated FDOH & CDC Self-Isolation Guidance

CTE Directors and Directors of Technical Colleges,

This email is in regards to the [CDC's updated guidance on self-isolation/quarantine](#) for people who come in close contact to someone with COVID-19. Attached are two documents you may find helpful.

These are the important changes in these documents from prior FDOH and CDC guidance:

- Regarding the “**CHD Guidance for Contact Tracing K-12 V5 final**” attachment, I would first focus on the “Quarantine” paragraph on page 1. This is the main new piece of information that reflects [the CDC's recent updated guidance](#). Most everything else appears to be excellent refreshers on prior guidance.
- Regarding the “**K12 School FAQ V5 final**” attachment, the definition of a “close contact” on the bottom half of page 3 and determining which students had close contact on the top half of page 4 are some of the most helpful explanations we've seen on these related topics. The question about a “return to school early” on page 4 is new information that complements the first attachment and [the CDC's recent updated guidance](#).
