Support to ensure ESE teachers are “in-field”



Eligible Content Areas

- Middle Grades General Science (5-9)
- Middle Grades Mathematics (5-9)
- Biology (6-12)
- Chemistry (6-12)
- Earth/Space General Science (6-12)
- Mathematics (6-12)
- Physics (6-12)
- Or holder of one of content areas above can add ESE (K-12)

How does it work?

- Apply and indicate teaching certificate number and content area you wish to test in
- SPDG purchases a voucher for the subject area exam (value of \$150)
- Upon passing the exam add the eligible content area to your teaching certificate
- Submit receipt and reimbursement voucher and get reimbursed for the fee (\$75 value)
