


Students are Optimizing Articulation

More than half of the upper division students enrolled in Florida's public universities in 2013-14 started in a Florida College System institution. These data support the importance and efficacy of Florida's "2+2" articulation agreements.

It is also worthy to note that while the vast majority of transfer students from Florida College Systems earned an associate of arts degree (85,762) over 3,000 students were able to transfer in with a workforce-focused associate of science degree.
