






High Quality Teachers for Every Florida Student

Background – Annual Program Performance Report (APPR) Metrics

- Placement rate of program completers into instructional positions in Florida public schools.
- Rate of retention for employed program completers in instructional positions in Florida public schools.
- Performance of students in pre-K through grade 12 who are assigned to in-field program completers on statewide assessments using the results of Florida's student learning growth formula.
- Performance of students in pre-K through grade 12 who are assigned to in-field program completers aggregated by student subgroup.
- Results of program completers' annual teacher evaluations.
- Production of program completers in statewide critical teacher shortage areas. (*Bonus Metric*)

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Setting the Stage

- State Board Presentation in January 2021
 - Critical Teacher Shortage Report
 - Annual Teacher Preparation Report
- The number of candidates going through traditional teacher preparation programs in Florida continues to decline.
- Although the number of candidates in state-approved teacher preparation programs has decreased, initial certification numbers continue to grow.


Background – Teacher Preparation Annual Report Executive Summary – Overall Findings

- **Key Highlights:**
 - Highest Rated Programs in 2020:
 - Elementary Education/ESOL/Reading at Florida Atlantic University
 - Middle Grades Mathematics at Indian River State College
 - The average placement rates for program completers was substantially higher from Florida College System (FCS) institutions than any other program category.
 - Elementary Education/ESOL/Reading at Florida Atlantic University and Reading at the University of Central Florida both received the highest score for student learning growth.
 - Forty-one programs improved their summative scores between 2019 and 2020, while 22 programs' scores decreased.
- **Opportunity for Further Consideration:**
 - 82 of 318 programs (26 percent) have enough performance data for their programs to receive a 2020 ranking.

Teacher Preparation Audit

- The purpose of the teacher preparation audit and review is to assess Florida's preparation programs, evaluating the following metrics:
 - Analysis of Florida's state-approved teacher preparation programs to understand if they are currently meeting the demands of Florida's public schools.
 - Analysis of Florida's state-approved teacher preparation programs to understand their impact on the production of quality teachers.
 - An analysis of Florida's teacher preparation accountability system to ensure metrics identify strengths and opportunities for programs to improve.
 - A review to determine and reevaluate the impact of the initial and continued approval process for Florida's state-approved teacher preparation programs.

Teacher Preparation Audit Timeline




