1. Welcome and Committee Updates	<p>Chair Hudson called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m., EDT, and welcomed members to the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) webinar.</p> <p>Chair Hudson noted that there were four action items on the agenda, along with an update on the Florida Department of Education’s Teacher Preparation Audit and a presentation from Department staff on a variety of articulation topics.</p>

2. Approval of June 17, 2021 Meeting Minutes	<p>Chair Hudson asked members if there were any changes to the meeting minutes; there were none. Chair Hudson then asked members if anyone would make a motion to approve the minutes.</p> <p><i>A motion to approve the minutes was made by Dr. Mann and was seconded by Dr. Gater; the meeting minutes were approved by unanimous vote.</i></p>
3. Approval of 2022 ACC Meeting Dates	<p>Chair Hudson asked members if there were any conflicts or concerns with the proposed ACC meeting dates; there were none. Chair Hudson then asked members if anyone would make a motion to approve the 2022 meeting dates.</p> <p><i>A motion to approve was made by Dr. Sidor and was seconded by Dr. Mann; the dates were approved by unanimous vote.</i></p>
4. Updates to the Program Requirements in	<p>Chair Hudson asked members if there were any questions regarding the Common Prerequisite Manual changes; there were none. Chair Hudson then asked members if anyone would make a motion to approve the changes.</p>

<p>the Common Prerequisite Manual as approved by the ACC Oversight Subcommittee</p>	<p><i>A motion to approve was made by Dr. Gater and was seconded by Dr. Sidor; the changes were approved by unanimous vote.</i></p>
<p>5. Approval of the Statewide Credit for Military Experience Equivalency List</p>	<p>Chair Hudson gave a brief overview of the process used to create the initial list, which includes course recommendations from members of the following discipline committees: Business Leadership, Management and Supervision; Electrical Engineering; Hospitality; Medical; and Welding. He then asked members if there were any questions regarding the Statewide Credit for Military Experience Equivalency List; there were none. Chair Hudson then asked members if anyone would make a motion to approve the list.</p> <p><i>A motion to approve was made by Dr. Jackson and was seconded by Dr. Riggs; the list was approved by unanimous vote.</i></p>

<p>6. DOE Teacher Preparation Audit Presentation</p>	<p>Dr. Paul Burns, Deputy Chancellor for Educator Quality in the Division of Public Schools provided an update on the DOE Teacher Preparation Audit.</p>
<p>7. DOE Update: Alternative Methods to Assess College-Level Computation and Communication</p>	<p>Dr. Carrie Henderson provided an update on alternative methods to assess college-level computation and communication. Temporary changes were put in place for students to demonstrate college-level readiness in computation and communication skills during the pandemic as states moved to alternative methods to measure student success. During the 2021 Legislative Session, Senate Bill 366 amended multiple Florida Statutes to expand the mechanisms institutions may use to assess readiness for college-level work. In addition to identifying approved common placement tests, the State Board of Education is required to adopt rules to develop and implement alternative methods for assessing communication and computation skills that specify the alternative methods and associated minimum standards that Florida College System (FCS) institutions may use. Once the rule is effective, FCS institutions may use approved alternative methods in lieu of, or in addition to, common placement test to determine college readiness for dual enrollment, developmental education, admissions and meta-major advising.</p>

<p>DOE Update: Civic Literacy Competency</p>	<p>Dr. Carrie Henderson also provided an update on civic literacy competencies. Senate Bill 1108 (2021) was amended to require students initially entering an FCS or State University System institution, to complete a course and pass an assessment to demonstrate competency in civic literacy.</p> <p>Additionally, the bill added a requirement that students taking United States Government in high school also take a civic literacy assessment. Students who pass the Florida Civic Literacy Examination will be exempt from the civic literacy competency assessment requirement upon matriculating to a public postsecondary institution.</p>
<p>DOE Update: General Education Core Course Options</p>	<p>Ms. Alexandria Armstrong provided an update on general education core course options. Beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year, students entering a technical degree education program must complete at least one identified core course in each subject area (Communication, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Sciences or Social Sciences) as part of the general education course requirements before being award a degree.</p>
<p>DOE Update: Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program</p>	<p>Ms. Armstrong also provided an update on the newly authorized Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program enacted by Section 1009.30, Florida Statutes. The program allows eligible postsecondary institutions to seek reimbursement for the tuition and instructional materials costs for public, private, and home education students participating in the dual enrollment program.</p> <p>Beginning in the 2021-2022 academic year, public postsecondary institutions with an approved articulation agreement on file with the Office of Articulation can request reimbursement for tuition and instructional materials costs for private and home education student participation in dual enrollment for the Fall and Spring terms. During the summer term, eligible institutions can request reimbursement for public, private and home education students.</p>
<p>DOE Update: Mathematics Pathways</p>	<p>Ms. Abbey Ivey provided an update on the Florida Student Success Center’s initiative to align mathematics pathways to programs of study. Based upon recommendation from the Florida Mathematics Re-Design Workgroups from June 2019, legislation was enacted during the 2021 Legislative Session to create three mathematics pathways for students that align courses to programs, meta-majors, and careers. A committee comprised of representatives from the SUS, FCS and school district career centers will collaborate to identify the three mathematics pathways and their corresponding courses sequences. The committee is tasked with finalizing the pathways and course sequences by December 2021; the ACC will consider the proposals at the February 2022 meeting.</p>

<p>DOE Update: Statewide Reverse Transfer Implementation</p>	<p>Ms. Armstrong provided a brief update on the implementation of the statewide reverse transfer process, which will begin during the Spring 2022 term.</p>
<p>Adjournment</p>	<p>Prior to adjournment, Chair Hudson asked if the Board of Governors (BOG) had any updates to share. Dr. Christy England provided a brief remark that the BOG Regulation related to civic literacy would be amended to align with the statutory requirements, which should be finalized in January 2022.</p> <p>Chair Hudson then asked members if anyone would make a motion to adjourn the meeting.</p> <p><i>A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Dr. Mann and was seconded by Dr. Gater; the adjournment was approved by unanimous vote.</i></p> <p>Chair Hudson adjourned the meeting at 2:20 p.m.</p>

Item #3: 2021-2022 Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements

The Office of Articulation will present the 2021-2022 Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements for approval.

Please see the attached Appendix A for revised or newly proposed agreements; a complete listing of agreements is provided below. Currently, there are 175 active agreements. For the 2021-2022 academic year, 21 new agreements have been developed that are aligned with 17 industry certifications on the 2021-2022 CAPE Industry Certification Funding List.

Agreements that are stricken are being removed; agreements in green are pending approval. Please note that the Florida College System adopted new 10-digit CIP codes to align with National Center for Education Statistics 2020 CIPs. As a result, many Associate in Science programs were issued new CIPs, which triggered changes to the Gold Standard Career Pathways Articulation Agreements.
