



Florida's Charter Schools

Charter schools are tuition-free public schools created through an agreement or "charter" typically between the school and the local district school board. This agreement gives the charter school a measure of expanded freedom relative to traditional public schools in return for a commitment to higher standards of accountability. Since 1996, Florida charter schools have played a key role in increasing parental options in public education and providing innovative learning opportunities for students.

During the 2019-20 school year, over 329,000 students were enrolled in 673 charter schools in 48 Florida districts. Many charter schools in Florida have innovative missions. Some charter schools include themed learning approaches focusing on areas such as arts, sciences, and technologies. Other charter schools provide services to special populations such as students at risk of academic failure or students with disabilities.





Charter Student Diversity

Florida's charter schools, which serve 53% low-income students statewide, have become increasingly diverse. In 2019-20, 69% of the students served were minorities. Hispanic students comprised 44% of Florida's charter school enrollment, and 19% were African-American students.

History of Charter School Application Approval Rate


