1. DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION: Submit a separate record during reporting period 5 for each student who participated in a Title 1, Title 1-Migrant, State Migrant, Title 1/Migrant, Title 1 Migrant/State Migrant or Homeless education program for both the school year and, if applicable, the summer session.

Submit an additional record for each subject area covered in the approved Title 1 plan (minimum is reading or language arts <u>and</u> math).

Transmit only one record for Homeless students who are not also served by Title 1.

- 2. TEST DATE: Title 1 requires the use of Blueprint 2000 transitional assessments (e.g. district norm-referenced tests in reading and math at grades 4 and 8, Grade Ten Assessment Test, Florida Writes! at grades 4, 8 and 10 and the High School Competency Test) at grade levels applicable for participating schools. These data need not be repeated in the Federal/State Compensatory Project Evaluation format. Title 1 also allows for additional assessments and/or indicators as a district option. When specified in the approved project plan and application, data from additional assessments and/or indicators must be transmitted through this format. Provide the midpoint (month, day, year) of the pretest and/or posttest administration period as specified in the approved project plan and application. This data element will be used for pretest and/or posttest dates for the Compensatory Project Evaluation for norm-referenced tests, additional assessments and for English language proficiency assessments. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)
- TEST SUBJECT CONTENT: The exact specifications for test score data are contained in the district's approved project plan and application. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)

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Multiple records for optional assessments or indicators can be submitted for students in any grade level, depending on the approved project plan and application.

- 4. TEST SCORE TYPE: Submit National Percentile scores, when available. If no National Percentile score exists for a particular test indicated in the approved plan or application, report the raw score. This could occur in the case of a criterion referenced or alternative assessment. For students served in local Neglected and Delinquent projects, it is permissible to submit grade equivalent scores if called for in the approved application. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)
- 5. TEST SCORE: Provide **test scores** originating <u>only</u> from the standardized test (or other evaluation instrument) and the test administration periods as specified in the approved project plan. Provide pretest and/or posttest results as specified. If a student has no test scores to report, enter 0's (zeroes) for all test information items. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)
- 6. TEST NAME: Use the codes provided in Appendix I to identify common norm-referenced tests (e.g. CTB, CAT, STA). If the test results specified in the approved project application come from an instrument <u>NOT</u> listed in Appendix I, use the X_ convention. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)
- 7. TERM. To show the student participated in a program during the regular school year, use code 3 (annual). To indicate summer participation, use S (Combined Summer Session). If the student participated in <u>both</u> regular school year <u>and</u> summer school sessions, send separate records indicating correct term.
- 8. FEDERAL/STATE PROJECT SCHOOL OF INSTRUCTION: This data element indicates the school in your district where the student will be credited for accountability purposes. Usually, this is where the student received the majority of his or her instruction. If the student attended more than one Title 1 school, the district may elect to use the school code for the superintendent's office. (Not applicable if Project Type equals 7.)
- 9. FEDERAL/STATE PROJECT DAYS OF INSTRUCTION: The total days of instruction are cumulative across all schools where Title 1, Migrant or Homeless services were provided in your district. This is an optional data element.

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- 10. FEDERAL/STATE PROJECT STATE SUPPORT SERVICES: Up to four support service codes may be reported for students receiving Title 1, Title 1 Migrant, State Migrant or Homeless services. With the exception of "Z", a support service code may be used only once. This is NOT required for support services provided by state funds.
- 11. PLACEMENT DATE: This data element indicates the date the student began receiving Title 1, Migrant or Homeless Education Program services for the current school year. This data element is optional for districts that elect to include a late enrollment date in their approved Title 1 plan and application.
- 12. KEY FIELDS: The key fields for this format are item numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 22. If a key field needs to be changed, the record must be deleted and resubmitted as an add.
