

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

2. Deleted 7/02.
3. The first nine positions of Student Number Identifier, Florida must be numeric. The tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida must either be an "X" or numeric. If the tenth position of Student Number Identifier, Florida is numeric, the first two digits must be a valid district number in the range 01-70 or 72-76. -record rejected-

Note: For additional information on Student Number Identifier, Florida refer to the DOE Information Data Base Requirements: Volume I -- Automated Student Information System, Appendix C, for acceptable codes.

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because when the social security number is used as the Student Number Identifier, Florida, the tenth position must be an "X". The fourth and sixth records would be rejected because the Student Number Identifier, Florida contains blanks. The fifth record would be rejected because the first two digits are not a valid district number.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Student Number Identifier, Florida and resubmit the records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

- 4. Survey Period Code must be F, W or S and must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The Survey Period Code as specified in the transmission Job Control Language (JCL) or in statements for tape transmission is identified as Survey Period "W". However, records on the transmission have a Survey Period Code "F". All update, adds or deletes with this inconsistency would be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The Survey Period Code must be corrected either on the records coming in or the transmission JCL and all records must be resubmitted.

- 5. WDIS Reporting Year must be correct for the submission specified by the district. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The WDIS Reporting Year as specified in the transmission JCL or in statements for tape transmission is identified as "0102". However, records on the transmission have WDIS Reporting Year coded as "0203". All updates, adds or deletes with this inconsistency will be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must correct the WDIS Reporting Year either on the records coming in or the transmission JCL and resubmit all records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

6. The Transaction Code must be A, C or D. For the original transmission, only A is valid. For subsequent batch/update submissions, if A is specified then the record must not already exist on the data base; if C or D is specified then the record must exist on the data base. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

For all original transmissions, the Transaction Code must be "A". An original transaction is the first submission of a record during a survey period. After original transmission of records, changes to the record for elements other than the key elements must be done with a "C" as the transaction code. To delete a record, the Transaction Code must be a "D". To change key elements in a batch transaction, the record must FIRST be deleted with a "D" and then added with an "A". Records with an incorrect Transaction Code would be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Transaction Code and resubmit the records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

7. **School Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numeric in the range of 0001 to 9899. -record rejected-**

EXAMPLE

The third record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and second records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service is not within the specified range or is not numeric.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the School Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

8. District Number, Current Instruction/Service must be numeric in the range 01-70 or 72-76 and must be correct for the district submitting the data. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

If District 01 is submitting records, District Number, Current Instruction/Service must be 01 for all records. In the records listed below, the first record would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected since the District Number, Current Instruction/Service is 02 rather than 01 (the number of the District submitting the record).

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the District Number, Current Instruction/Service and resubmit the record.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

9. Section Number must not be all blanks. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The second record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first record would be rejected because the Section Number contains all blanks.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the Section Number and resubmit the record.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

12. Grade Level must be 09-12, 30 or 31. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first, fifth and sixth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second, third and fourth records would be rejected because Grade Level is invalid.

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because the Adult Educational Functioning Level, Initial code is not valid.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

17. The code for Vocational/Adult General Education, Disability, Student must be I, N or Z. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education, Disability, Student code is not valid.

22. The Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be an adult general education program number from the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730). -record rejected-

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education (AGE) Program Code is not valid.

25. Course Number must not contain blanks and must be a valid Course Number for the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) unless the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code equals 9900010. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third and fourth records would be rejected because in each case the Course Number is not a valid number for the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code on the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit file.

Each record must be unique based on Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; WDIS Reporting Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; and Section Number. -First record accepted, all other duplicate records rejected-

EXAMPLE

The fifth and eighth records listed below would be rejected because the key items (Student Number Identifier, Florida; Survey Period Code; WDIS Reporting Year; District Number, Current Instruction/Service; School Number, Current Instruction/Service; Course Number; and Section Number) duplicate the key items in a previous record. The first of two records with the same key information will be loaded to the data base file, assuming they meet all other applicable criteria. Any subsequent records submitted with duplicate data in all the key items would be rejected.

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the records that were accepted and loaded to the data base are the correct ones, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must delete any invalid records, correct any rejected records, if necessary, and resubmit the corrected records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

30. School Number, Current Instruction/Service must exist as a valid number in the District Number, Current Instruction/Service on the Master School Identification File. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The fourth and fifth records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The first, second and third records would be rejected because the School Number, Current Instruction/Service does not exist on the Master School Identification file.

32. The Adult Educational Functioning Level, Initial code set used must agree with the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code and the Course Number in the following table:

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the data base, the district must correct the relationship between the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code and the Adult Educational Functioning Level, Initial code and resubmit the records.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

→ 34. The Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code must be 9900000 - 9900300 or S990001. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code is inappropriate for this format.

39. Cost Reporting Code must equal 400. -record rejected-

The second record listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first and third records would be rejected because the Cost Reporting Codes are invalid for this format.

WDIS ADULT GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENT COURSE - REJECT RULES

42. If the Vocational/Adult General Education Completion Point Codes are other than Z or blank, then the reported codes must be left justified, with no embedded blanks, and valid for the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code reported for the student unless the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code equals 9900010. -record rejected-

Note: Use the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Edit File (DATASET NAME = DPS.DISTRICT.GQ.F61730.Y0001) for the comparison of Vocational Occupational Completion Point Codes.

EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the data base assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Completion Point Code is incompatible with the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code reported for the student.

The second record would be rejected because the Vocational/Adult General Education Completion Point Code field contains a repeated code and the Vocational/Adult General Education Program Code does not equal 9900010.
