<b>T</b>	<b>Teenage Parent Program</b> – A child care program provided by the district for the child(ren) of a parent or parents who are enrolled in or who have completed a Teenage Parent program and who are enrolled full-time in a public school in the district.		
<b>S</b>	<b>Funded Through Other Source(s)</b> – A prekindergarten program operated by a local school district which is funded through a source(s) other than those listed above.		
<b>V</b>	<b>Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program</b> – A prekindergarten education program delivered by a public school for children who have attained the age of four-years-old on or before September 1 of the school year in which the child is eligible to attend.		
<b>Z</b>	<b>Not Applicable</b> – Not a prekindergarten student.
