<u>Fee Exempt Categories</u>	
<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
F	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student does not have a high school diploma or its equivalent; (1009.25(1)(a), F.S.) and is enrolled in adult basic skills, adult secondary education, or vocational preparatory instruction.
G	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student has a high school diploma or its equivalent; and is enrolled in adult basic skills, adult secondary education or vocational preparatory instruction; and has basic skills which have been determined to be at or below the eighth grade level as provided for by State Board Rule (1009.25(1)(b), F.S.)
I	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is a dependent of a deceased or disabled veteran pursuant to Section 295.01 through 295.05, F.S.
J	<u>Fee Waiver:</u> The student is a dependent of a deceased special risk member (Sections 112.19(3) F.S., and 112.191(3), F.S.)
K	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is enrolled in an approved registered apprenticeship program as defined in s. 446.021, F.S. (1009.25(2)(b)F. S.)
L	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is mentally handicapped (as defined in Rule 6A-6.03011, FAC and Rule 6A-6.084, FAC)
M	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is a recipient of a Road-to-Independence Scholarship, or who is or was at the time he or she reached 18 years of age in the custody of a relative under s. 39.5085, F.S. or who was adopted from the Department of Children and Family Services after May 5, 1997.
N	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is enrolled in an employment and training program under the welfare transition program to (s. 1009.25(2)(d),, F.S.)
P	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> Any student who lacks a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence or whose primary nighttime residence is a public or private shelter designed to provide temporary residence for individuals intended to be institutionalized , or a public or private place not designed for, or ordinarily used as, a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings (1009.25(2)(e), F.S.)
Q	<u>Fee Exempt:</u> The student is enrolled in a dual enrollment or early admission program and has taken the basic skills assessment within the first six weeks of enrollment (1009.25(2)(a); 1007.271).
T	<u>Fee Waived:</u> Fee shall be waived for victims of wrongful conviction.
