Certificate awarded to an adult student who completed all of the requirements to receive an adult standard high school diploma, including a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, except passing the state approved graduation test or alternate assessment. Students who receive this certificate of completion are eligible to take the College Placement Test and be admitted to remedial or credit courses at a state community college, as appropriate.
