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<b>Element Name:</b> Duration, Disciplinary Action									
<b>Definition/Domain</b>									
<p>A three-digit number locally assigned within a district to indicate the duration for the following disciplinary actions: in-school suspension, out-of-school suspension, extended suspension, change in placement (students with disabilities only), expulsion or alternative placement.</p> <p>Example:</p> <table> <tr> <td>008</td> <td>Student served in-school suspension lasting eight school days</td> </tr> <tr> <td>010</td> <td>Student served out-of-school suspension lasting ten school days</td> </tr> <tr> <td>000</td> <td>Not applicable (The disciplinary action was not one for which days are assigned.).</td> </tr> <tr> <td>002</td> <td>Student served extended suspension beyond the 10 out-of-school suspension days.</td> </tr> </table> <p>Note: The field must not contain blanks.</p> <p> S. 1003.01(5) and (6), F.S.</p> <p> (5) SUSPENSION. —</p> <p> (a) Suspension, also referred to as out-of-school suspension, is the temporary removal of a student from all classes of instruction on public school grounds and all other school-sponsored activities, except as authorized by the principal or the principal's designee, for a period not to exceed 10 school days and remanding of the student to the custody of the student's parent with specific homework assignments for the student to complete.</p> <p> (b) In-school suspension is the temporary removal of a student from the student's regular school program and placement in an alternative program, such as that provided in <u>s. 1003.53, F.S.</u> under the supervision of school district personnel, for a period not to exceed 10 school days. (6) EXPULSION – Expulsion is the removal of the right and obligation of a student to attend a public school under conditions set by the school board, and for a period of time not to exceed the remainder of the term or school year and 1 additional year of attendance. Expulsions may be imposed with or without continuing educational services and shall be reported accordingly.</p>		008	Student served in-school suspension lasting eight school days	010	Student served out-of-school suspension lasting ten school days	000	Not applicable (The disciplinary action was not one for which days are assigned.).	002	Student served extended suspension beyond the 10 out-of-school suspension days.
