Temporary Certificates-General Knowledge Requirement

- Insert paragraph specifying the requirement to satisfy mastery of general knowledge in the first calendar year of employment under the temporary certificate
 - Options:
 - Passing scores on FTCE General Knowledge Test
 - Valid, state or national, standard educator certificates
 - College teaching experience
 - Passing scores on Graduate Record Examination (GRE)



Temporary Certificates- Expired

Insert clarifying language to prohibit the issuance of a new temporary certificate, even after a break in continuity, if the applicant has not satisfied the mastery of general knowledge requirement per Section 1012.56(3), Florida Statutes (F.S.)



Temporary Certificates- Extensions

- Insert language permitting the request for extension of a Temporary Certificate
 - for one (1) year if the educator has earned an effective or highly effective rating on his/her most recent state VAM score (per <u>2017 House</u> <u>Bill 7069</u>) teaching <u>courses</u> in language arts, math and Algebra
 - for two (2) years if the educator is the spouse of an active duty military servicemember (per <u>2018 House Bill 29</u>)
- When requirements for the Professional Certificate were not completed, but mastery of general knowledge is satisfied



Professional Certificate-STEM Pathway

 Update STEM Course List to reflect recent legislation and adoption of the 2018-2019 Course Code Directory

Courses To Be Added	Courses To Be Removed
 AICE Computer Science/Technology IB Sports Exercise Science 	 Algebra 2 AICE Physical Science AS Level AICE Further 2 A Level Math and Pre-AICE International Math



Special Certificates- Speech Language Impaired (SLI)

- Insert clarifying language to specify that the special certificates covering SLI:
 - two-year Temporary Certificate and
 - nonrenewable five-year
 Professional Certificate

...may each be issued only <u>one</u> time to a qualified educator.



Athletic Coaching Certificates

 Specify that applicants evaluated for an athletic coaching certificate will receive a letter valid for one (1) year outlining any remaining requirements for issuance of the certificate



Special Temporary Certificates-Educational Leadership

- Replace reference to Rule 6A-4.0081
 F.A.C., repealed in 2017, with the reference to certification in an Administrative Class subject coverage
- Add provision for military commissioned and non-commissioned officers to be eligible for a special Temporary Certificate in Ed Leadership and acceptance to a Level II Program (per House Bill 29)



Revoked Certificates

 Insert language prohibiting the reinstatement of a revoked or otherwise surrendered professional certificate regardless if the revocation is permanent or temporary
