## Global Business Rules

1. Secondary programs subject to the audit and related accountability include:
  - Career Preparatory (CAR-PREP) and
  - Technology Education (Tech-Ed) programs, only.
2. The Secondary CTE Audit defines a concentrator as a student who has earned the credit amounts below in a single secondary CTE program<sup>1</sup>:
  - For programs three (3) credits or more in length
    - 3 or more credits in the same program, OR
    - 2 or more high school credits and 1 or more dual enrollment credits in the same program, OR
    - 1 or more high school credits and 2 or more dual enrollment credits in the same program
  - For programs two and a half (2.5) credits in length
    - 2.5 or more credits in the same program; of which at least 1 must be a high school credit
  - For programs two (2) credits in length
    - 2 or more credits in the same program; of which at least 1 must be a high school credit
  - For programs one and a half (1.5) credits in length
    - 1.5 or more credits in the same program; of which at least 1 must be a high school credit
3. 12<sup>th</sup> Grader Concentrators included in the denominator for each metric are limited to concentrators who were enrolled for all four years in a Florida public high school in the same District of Enrollment.<sup>2</sup>
4. Any concentrator achievement is credited to the district where the student was enrolled for all 4 years of high school, only.
5. Programs that do not meet the outlined primary target or the alternate target are flagged for phase out<sup>3</sup>.

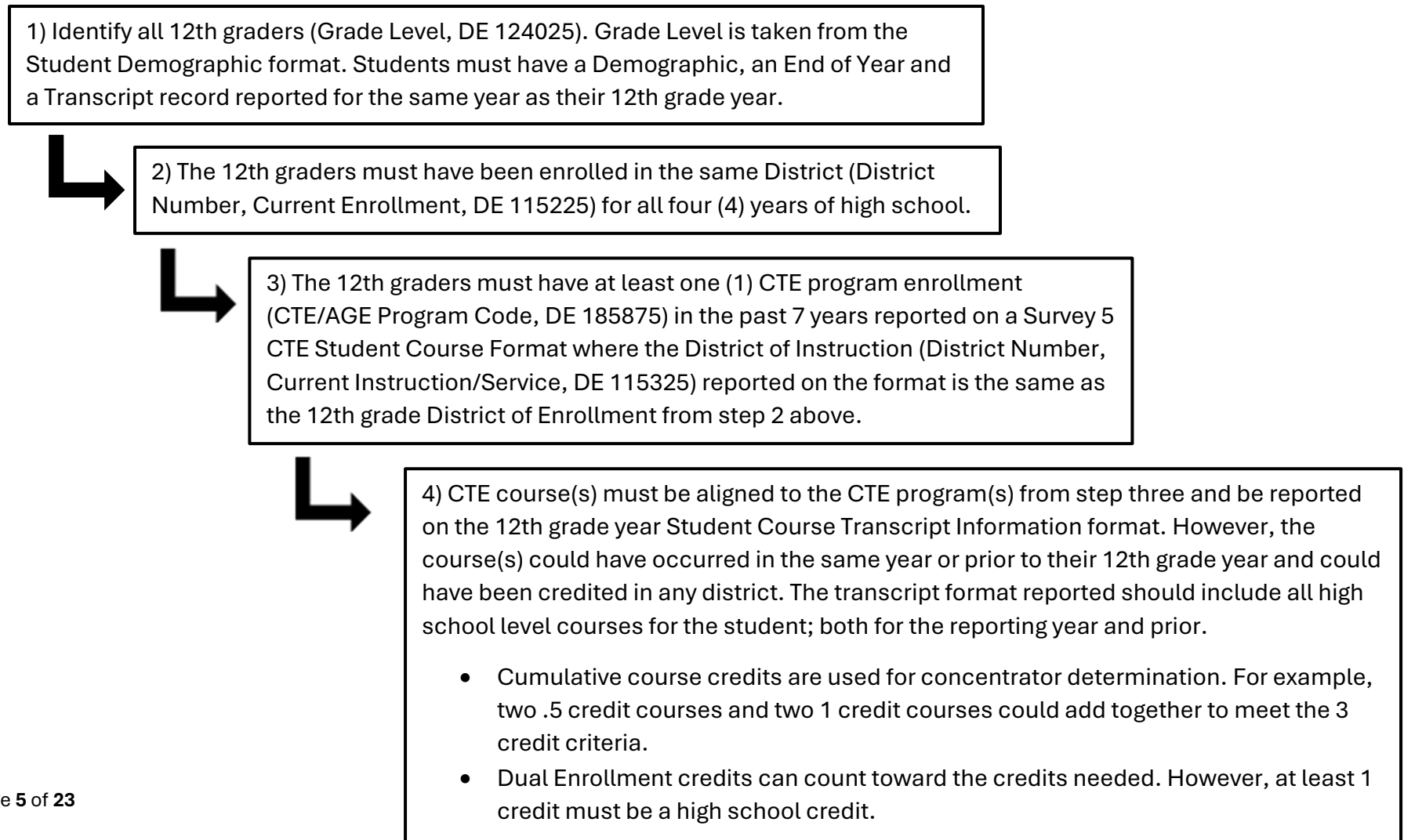

<sup>6</sup> Continuing education tracking uses final survey data. Continuing education tracking does not require students to have a valid SSN as tracking is done using student identifiers such as the FLEID and student ID.

<sup>7</sup> To track students into employment, a valid SSN is required. Students without a valid SSN are included in the denominator for employment tracking. Employment tracking capabilities are currently limited to traditional/W-2, in-state employment.
