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## Header and Generic Records Formats

### I/S/P00 Header Record Format

*Revised: October 21, 2025*

1. The presence of binary zeroes in data fields causes significant problems for several institutions in the receipt of student records. A transaction will be rejected if non-displayable characters are sent in the data unless found in Unique Institutional Identifier or in Filler Reserved for Local Use. Please use some other appropriate character (e.g., SPACES) with which to initialize your records before sending them.
2. Districts requesting a transcript from a postsecondary institution should use record type P00.
3. Special characters, tilde (~), caret (^), and grave accent (`), are used as delimiters in the translation of FASTER to SPEEDE/ExPRESS. They are reserved symbols and as such cannot be included in data sent through FASTER to a SPEEDE/ExPRESS institution.
4. Required fields are indicated by an asterisk (\*) next to the field name.

### Generic Record Format (G99)

*Effective: August 1, 2015*

1. Record Type: G99 - This record is used to transfer data not specifically detailed in the three approved FASTER formats (Interdistrict, Secondary, or Postsecondary/Technical Center). The sending and receiving institutions must define the data to be sent in columns 4 through 1011. Note that columns 1-3 must be 'G99' and data found in columns 1012-1020 will be ignored.
2. The presence of LOW-VALUES in data fields causes significant problems for several institutions in the receipt of student records. A transaction will be rejected if non-displayable characters are sent in the data unless found in Filler Reserved for Local Use. Please use some other appropriate character (e.g., SPACES) with which to initialize your records before sending them.

### SPEEDE/ExPRESS Generic Health Screening Record Format (G99HS)

*Effective: August 1, 2015*

1. Record Type: G99 - This record would be sent with transactions that do not strictly adhere to any of the three approved FASTER formats (Interdistrict, Secondary, Postsecondary/Technical Center).
2. National Record Type: HS - This record is used to provide the receiving institution with information concerning health screening activities.

A transaction will be rejected if non-displayable characters are sent in the data unless found in Filler Reserved for Local Use. Please use some other appropriate character (e.g., SPACES) with which to initialize your records before sending them.
