**ORDER REFERRING MOTION TO DISMISS TO STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

This matter is before the undersigned on Appellee's Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction and Appellee's Motion to Extend Time to File Answer. The Chair of the Charter School Appeal Commission is required to rule upon evidentiary, procedural, and non-jurisdictional motions submitted prior to the Commission hearing. Rule 6A-6.0781, F.A.C.

It is ORDERED that:

1. Appellee's Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction is being referred to the State Board of Education at its July 16, 2025, meeting.
2. Having considered the Motion to Extend and Appellee's representation that Appellant has no objection to the Motion to Extend, Appellee's Motion to Extend is GRANTED.
3. If the State Board of Education denies Appellee's Motion to Dismiss or otherwise advises the Charter School Appeal Commission to hear Appellant's Appeal, Appellee must file its Answer within ten (10) days of the State Board's decision.


