**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Rule 6A-10.0342, F.A.C., specifies the process for the audit of secondary and postsecondary career programs, which requires the Commissioner of Education to conduct an annual review of K-12 and postsecondary career and technical education offerings, commonly known as the "CTE audit."

This amendment clarifies the phase-out process such that the duration is increased for phase out documentation, and out-of-state continuing education and employment can be considered for supplemental evidence for related metrics. The amendment also adds details to the teach out and reinstatement processes for phased out CTE programs, updates the website URLs and reduces overall redundancy.
