EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed rule establishes the standards for enrollment of students in and reporting of instructional hours for funding by school districts which offer postsecondary career certificate and applied technology diploma programs. The rule includes key definitions, the parameters for instructional hours reporting, and special circumstances related to reporting. The rule would take effect for reporting of enrollment in the fall term of 2026.
