SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment to Rule 6A-10.024, Articulation Between and Among Universities, Florida Colleges, and School Districts

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to modify Rule 6A-10.024, Florida Administrative Code, so that it incorporates the Credit by Examination List for the 2026-2027 school year.

One of the changes included in this annual adoption is an interim passing score for the FACT: College Algebra assessment, administered this past spring to the students participating in the pilot of the course and the assessment. When a new test is delivered to a population of test takers who are exposed to content assessed for the first time, it is common and consistent with best practices in high-stakes assessment to hold official scores until which time an appropriate review and research of the statistical properties of the test can be fully evaluated.

The interim passing score of 60% is based on the current analysis of the performance of the test items as administered during the pilot as described above. Scores will be released to participating students once this interim passing score is approved.
