The Department of Education plans to initiate rule development for [Rule 6A-10.0315, F.A.C., Demonstration of Readiness for College-Level Communication and Computation](#). The purpose of the rule amendment is to add the Classic Learning Test 10 (CLT10) as an additional alternative method assessment option. Additionally, the amendment addresses the assessment of college-level communication and computation skills of students who intend to enter an A.S. or A.A.S. degree program at an approved district career center, pursuant to s. 1007.331, F.S.
