SUBJECT: Articulation Coordinating Committee Approval of Revised Common

Prerequisites for the Florida College System (FCS) Bachelor of Science in

Nursing Program

In 2022, the Division of Florida Colleges (DFC) requested that all FCS institutions conduct a technical accuracy review of their active baccalaureate degree program inventory in the Common Prerequisites Manual (CPM) to ensure that the manual contains accurate information that reflects the baccalaureate program prerequisites that were approved by the State Board of Education or any subsequent changes made to the program prerequisites that were approved by the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC).

Using that information, the DFC assembled Subject Matter Experts (SME) in FCS nursing programs to review the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) (CIP code 51.3801, Track 2 (Post-Licensure)) program prerequisites and to recommend changes, if necessary. Concurrent to this review, State University System institutions also conducted a similar review of the CPM and put forth its recommendations to revise the CPM for the BSN under the CIP code 51.3801, Track 1 (Pre-Licensure).

On June 4, 2025, the ACC approved revisions to the BSN statewide program prerequisites under the Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) code 51.3801 in the CPM.

Below are the program prerequisites approved by the ACC.

Each FCS institution should review the approved revised prerequisites and take any necessary action to be consistent with the changes, which will go into effect for the 2026-27 academic year.

Additionally, FCS institutions may need to modify their advising practices and update institutional catalogs, websites and any other student-facing program information to reflect the revised prerequisites as they appear in the CPM as well as inform academic advisors of the changes to the BSN program prerequisites.
