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Recently Completed Accountability Tasks

- **Student Data Updates:** Web application closed May 22, 2026.
- **Assessment Matching:** Prior year assessments and current year assessments through Winter administration.
- **School Types:** Review period closed May 20, 2026.

School Grades Escalator Clause Reminder

- Pursuant to section 1008.34(3)(c)1., Florida Statutes, when over 75% of schools of a specific school type receive a grade of “A” or “B,” the grading scale for that school type is automatically adjusted to reset the minimum required percentage of points for each grade of “A,” “B,” “C” or “D” at the next highest percentage point ending in numeral 5 or 0, whichever is closest to the current percentage.

School Grades Escalator Clause Reminder, Cont.

- The school grading scales for high schools and combination schools have been adjusted upward for the 2025-26 school year, as more than 75% of schools in each of these categories earned a grade of “A” or “B” in the 2024-25 academic year.
- Because the district grading scale aligns with the combination school grading scale as required in Rule 6A-1.09981(5), Florida Administrative Code, the district grading scale has also been adjusted upward for the 2025-26 school year.

2025-26 School Grading Scales

School Grade	Scale Range (Elementary)	Scale Range (Middle)
A	62%-100%	64%-100%
B	54%-61%	57%-63%
C	41%-53%	44%-56%
D	32%-40%	34%-43%
F	0%-31%	0%-33%

2025-26 School and District Grading Scales

School Grade	Scale Range (High, Combination and District)
A	65%-100%
B	60%-64%
C	45%-59%
D	35%-44%
F	0%-34%

School Improvement Rating

3-Year Aggregate

- 2025-26 is the first year since transition to the new standards where three years of learning gains data will be available.
- If a school does not have enough data for at least one component in the current year, the data for that school will be aggregated using the current year and the two most recent years of data.

Federal Percent of Points Index (FPPI)

- WIDA ACCESS – updated WIDA assessment that will undergo standard setting over the summer.
- Scores will not be available in time to use in the 2025-26 FPPI calculations; English Language Proficiency Progress component will not be calculated.
- English Language Learners subgroup will still receive FPPI.

Value-Added Models (VAM)

- In 2025-26, the 3-year aggregate will include up to three consecutive years of data.
 - Three years of data over a three-year span:
 - **2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26.**

VAM Reminders

- VAM data are provided to districts no later than July 31 annually to ensure adequate time to incorporate the results into personnel evaluations, if required by the district, and to inform school improvement plans.
