<p>Monday, January 26th</p>	<p>Read, White and Blue Day – Celebrating 250 Chapters of America Students and Staff will wear their favorite patriotic attire. This day will focus on Reading as the main teaching instruction. Guest speakers will be invited to read aloud grade appropriate books that celebrate America’s history. At the secondary level, students and teachers will be engaging in historical speeches and prominent court cases that shaped America. History classes will analyze the Preamble.</p>
<p>Tuesday, January 27th</p>	<p>Military Appreciation Day – Students and Staff will wear their favorite Camo attire. This day will focus on Writing as the main teaching instruction. Students will write thank you letters to a military person that is connected to school personnel at their school. Videos of former teachers who are in the military will be broadcasted at our Secondary schools. Care packages will be sent with the thank you letters.</p>
<p>Wednesday, January 28th</p>	<p>Stars and Stripes Day – Students and Staff will wear their favorite American flag shirts. This day will focus on Listening as the main teaching instruction. Students will be listening to and analyzing the Star Spangle Banner and having discussions about its meaning. Teachers will be encouraged to use excerpts of American authors to support learning in their classrooms.</p>
<p>Thursday, January 29th</p>	<p>American Heroes Day – Students and Staff will dress as their favorite American worker or Everyday hero. This day will focus on Speaking as the main teaching instruction. Students will be given the opportunity to present their outfit and why they chose that profession or person as their American Hero. Elementary grades will participate in an “American Hero Parade”. Secondary students and staff will focus on historical speeches and biographies. They will rewrite speeches in today’s language.</p>
