<p><b>Monday, January 26<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>“Hallway Timeline!”</b> Wear red, white, and/or blue! Each class decorates a door as one “chapter” of America’s history (Colonies, Civil Rights, Space Age, etc.).</p>
<p><b>Tuesday, January 27<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>“Patriotic Read-In on the Field!”</b> Dress in colonial attire. Read books about patriots. Bring blankets and books to read outside.</p>
<p><b>Wednesday, January 28<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>It’s “Western Wednesday!”</b> Dress like pioneers or Western story characters - cowboys/cowgirls.</p>
<p><b>Thursday, January 29<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>“Time-Travel Thursday!”</b> – Dress up as characters throughout history (i.e., George Washington, Thurgood Marshall, Harriet Tubman, Amelia Earhart, etc.).</p>
<p><b>Friday, January 30<sup>th</sup></b></p>	<p><b>“Stars &amp; Stripes Storytime!”</b>- Students wear red, white, and blue and/or stars and stripes. Read books about American landmarks, symbols, and geography.</p>
