<p>Wednesday, January 28th</p>	<p>Stars, Stripes and Patriotic Poetry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SCSO Educator Academy tutors will visit elementary classrooms to read aloud patriotic books. • Students will use what they learned from their research to write an acrostic poem (America, Freedom, United States), a haiku, or a limerick.
<p>Thursday, January 29th</p>	<p>American Heroes in Our Schools</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classrooms will host America's History Timeline activities to highlight important events and people in America's 250-year history as a country. • Patriotic Storytime with Our Heroes-guest readers from the community (police, fire, military, veteran, doctor, nurse, etc.)
