Florida Instructional Materials Center for the Visually Impaired (FIMC-VI): Launching of New Portal and Related Training

The new FIMC-VI Portal will officially launch on October 1, 2025, offering an improved experience for student registration and textbook ordering. Please note that the current FIMC-VI Online System will be permanently shut down on September 16, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. ET. Be sure to complete any necessary tasks in the current system before that time.

The new FIMC-VI Portal is designed to feel more like familiar online shopping platforms, making it easier to manage student information and textbook orders. Two options for a training session are being offered. During the session, participants will learn how to: sign in and recover passwords, approve new users in their organization, register and manage student information, search for textbooks and place orders, and much more. Important updates to the textbook ordering process that will take effect later this school year will also be covered.

To accommodate different schedules, this training will be held twice and recorded: **September 26**, **2025**, from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. ET or **October 1**, **2025**, from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. ET. Informational Items

2025 Disability History and Awareness Weeks

Signed into law in 2008, section 1003.4205, Florida Statutes, Disability History and Awareness Instruction, requires Florida school districts, to designate the first two weeks of October as "Disability History and Awareness Weeks." The 2025 Florida Legislature passed, and Governor DeSantis signed into law on May 20, 2025, House Bil (HB) 447. HB 447 became effective on July 1, 2025, and provides a list of topics by grade for districts planning to participate in disability history and awareness instruction. During these two weeks, schools can provide intensive instruction to students to expand their overall knowledge, understanding and awareness of individuals with disabilities; the history of disability; and the disability rights movement.

With less than two months until the start of Disability History and Awareness Weeks, BEESS is asking districts to begin identifying any events or learning opportunities planned for the first two weeks of October and submitting ideas for planned events to DOEBEESS@fldoe.org. Be sure to include specifics such as event details and dates, if possible.

Restraint Data for July 2025 is Now Available

July 2025 data for restraint incidents submitted to the Involuntary Examination, Restraint, and Seclusion (known as IERS) web application is now available. The data have been posted to the Program Accountability, Assessments & Data Systems web page and can be located by scrolling down to the section titled "SWD Restraint Data – SY 2025-26," and selecting the appropriate month. Pursuant to section 1003.573(8), Florida Statutes, "The department shall maintain aggregate data of incidents of restraint and disaggregate the data for analysis by county, school, student exceptionality, and other variables, including the type and method of restraint used. This information shall be updated monthly, deidentified, and made available to the public through the department's website.

SBPIE ASSESSMENT

FIN-Trained Leader Training

For schools required to complete the SBPIE in 2025-26, FIN is providing three virtual options for the required training for individuals who will be leading the School BPIE Assessment process at their schools. Participation in this training requires school-level access to the SBPIE section of the Bureau of Exceptional Education and Student Services General Supervision Website. Implementation of this training to complete the SBPIE Assessment will partially satisfy requirements of section 1003.57, Florida Statutes (F.S.), regarding the triennial completion of the SBPIE. Following the SBPIE Assessment, additional actions are needed regarding subsequent short- and long-term improvement planning based on selected priority indicators.


